**COM2 Public Speaking** Mon 8am Tue & Thurs 9am (3SH)

This course will encourage the development of communication skills together with the practical application thereof, especially as it pertains to delivering various kinds of formal speeches. Students will learn how to: 1) Speak to various groups including charities, social clubs local government councils and business associations; 2) Address an audience on radio and/or television with a teaching, announcement or commercial; 3) Introduce another speaker and give welcoming speeches, special occasion speeches, speeches to exhort, inform, entertain or persuade; and 4) Learn how to properly facilitate any meeting according to Robert's Rules of Order as well as how to lead or participate in a panel discussion. Prerequisite: Permission of instructor

**LDR2 Free to Lead – Fundamentals** Wed 8-12pm (3SH)

Course is designed to lead the student to receive freedom from inner turmoil and life destroying habits. Topics covered will be ungodly beliefs, confession and forgiveness, healing of soul/spirit hurts, deliverance from oppression and bondage, breaking vows, disassociation with family curses, and freedom from bitterness and offenses. The student will participate in survey, assessment, analysis and receive ministry where needed. Prerequisites: None.

**LDR2 Personal Finances** Fri 9-12pm (3SH)

This course will focus on equipping the students for financial success by helping them incorporate the necessary building blocks into their personal finances. The course will include instruction in budgeting, cash flow, stewardship and four streams of income. Video teaching will be employed to reinforce and augment teacher instruction. Prerequisites: None.

**LDR2 Supreme Leader – Jesus, the Christ** Mon 9am Tue&Thurs 10am (3SH)

A devotional course to aid the student in the discovery of Jesus as a leader, anointed by the Spirit, full of purpose and passion. The gospels will be used as source materials. The student will be expected to pursue a deeper relationship with Jesus in order to be impacted personally by His life. Special attention will be given to the techniques, attitude and heart for people demonstrated by Jesus during His years of leading His disciples. Prerequisites: None

**MIN2 Bible Survey** Mon - Tue – Thurs 11am (3SH)

This course will include survey of the OT, survey of the NT and Bible methodology. The student will become familiar with the books of the Bible, important dates, history of major events, covenants, themes, important historical figures and how the Bible came to be. Commonly used methods of study and interpretation of the Bible will be presented and practiced. Prerequisite: None

**LDR Leader Development** Tue-Wed-Fri 8am (NC)

It is essential to effective leadership in all pursuits of life that the leader develops a lifestyle of personal worship centered on Jesus Christ. This course is intended to establish a life of discipleship and worship as the student participates in the consistent opportunities provided multiple times during the week. To succeed in this course the students must be regular attendees and demonstrate their skill through participation and leading a group. Prerequisites: None.
